In the context of Missouri's SB 40, group personal assistance refers to collective services where care and support—such as help with daily living tasks, communication, or mobility—are provided to a group rather than on an individual basis. Additional funding through SB 40 ensures that individuals with developmental disabilities have access to the resources and supports they need to live fulfilling, independent lives within their communities.
